Employee Communication – 4/24/2020

“This week, Governor Tom Wolf introduced his plan for the reopening of Pennsylvania. This will impact The Learning Lamp’s employees differently. As of now, Cambria and Somerset counties will reopen on the same timeline as Westmoreland and Allegheny counties. Bedford and Blair counties may reopen sooner due to distance from densely populated areas.

We do know that child care programs are slated to reopen in the second phase of Wolf’s plan. We are tentatively planning for a May 11 start date for child care programs. This is subject to change based on guidance from the Commonwealth. Most school employees will not return until the start of the 2020-21 school year, although some may be recalled sooner to help get programs up and running.

As you can see, the situation is fluid. We are monitoring things closely and will update you when we know more. Your patience is greatly appreciated as we navigate this difficult situation. Enjoy your weekend and reach out if you have questions or need emergency assistance.”
