“A note to let you know that we are in the beginning stages of reopening. It will be a slow process with health and safety protocols in place to protect our most valuable asset—you! A handful of child care programs opened on Monday. As expected, the number of children returning was low. We believe attendance will rise over time as parents are required to return to work.

This week was mostly focused on getting into the new routine, which includes drop-offs at the front door, temperature checks, masking, and frequent cleaning. It takes a little time to adjust to the new dynamic.
